Theft or loss of personal and/or sensitive data

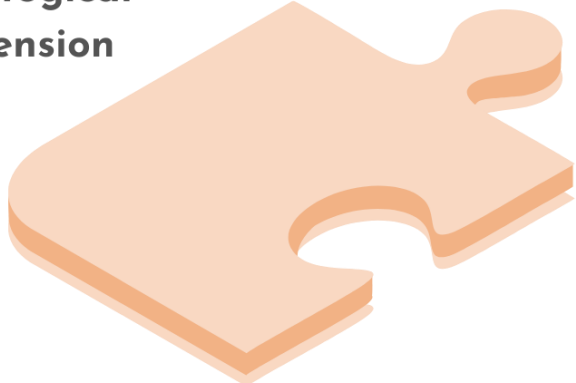
